Child Safety Corner

Please note: Be sure to DRIVE SLOW through our ELC parking lot. We are working with our Foxrock management re' signage to remind drivers to **Slow Down** and be aware of children entering and exiting cars.

Never Leave a Child Alone in a Car; Not Even for a Minute!



Reminder to all ELC families: Our security system is designed to allow access to those with key FOBs, and keep those who do not have them out until a staff member can let them in. Please do not hold the door open for anyone. All families who are enrolled have their own FOB. Thank you!

Here are some suggestions for making this feel less awkward:

- Ask the approaching person if they have a FOB. If not, ring the doorbell together and wait.
- Point to the sign on the door asking families not to hold the door for others, "Please do not hold the door open for others. It's not rude, it's safety."

Please arrive at school by 9:00am- when your child arrives on time, they are able to start their day according to the daily routine. Routine and structure are essential for young children.



Call the Center if your child will be late or absent- when you call the Center to alert us to your child's absence we know that your child is safe and

accounted for. Please call the Center by 9:00am if your child will be absent/late. Early Learning Center staff will begin calling families of children unaccounted for at 9:30am. We will call all adults listed on enrollment forms until we reach an authorized person. Please note if we have not heard from the absent child's family by 10:30am, local police will be contacted to ensure the child's safety.

Please leave a message- when you leave a message at the Center we will call you back quickly! The best time for families to call the Center is during rest time daily (1:00-2:30pm) to inquire about your child's day directly with your child's teacher!
