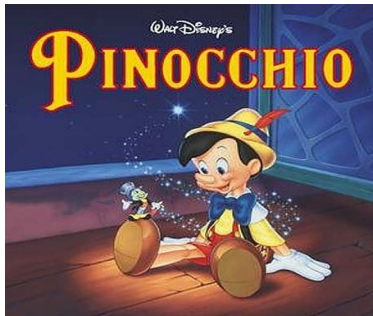


EXPLORING DISNEY ANIMATION
