*Nature Center Preschool is located at the South Shore Natural Science Center in Norwell. Founded in 1962, the SSNSC includes 30 acres of land crossed by 6 interpretive trails through woodland, meadow, pond, bog and swamp. It is surrounded by 200 acres of town conservation recreation land.*

**Nature Center Preschool** combines the idea of a traditional preschool program with all the extra opportunities and excitement offered by the facilities and staff of the South Shore Natural Science Center.

Naturalists from the Science Center visit the preschool regularly to provide enrichment activities. Children will explore the Center's diverse habitats on frequent trail walks. Indoor activities include visiting live animals, experiencing the assorted collections of the Center as well as the museum exhibits.



We emphasize hands-on learning for the naturally curious young child. As preschoolers ask questions, teachers encourage them to find the answers through discussion, making guesses, using their senses, and experimenting. This use of the scientific method opens up pathways to lifelong learning in all areas of development.

### **PHILOSOPHY**

Nature Center Preschool encourages each child to learn and grow in all areas of development as he/she gains love and respect for our natural world through exploration and hands-on activities.

The nature program of Nature Center Preschool is designed to meet the interests, abilities, and learning needs of young children.

### **ACTIVITIES**

- ✧ Active exploration that fosters children's natural curiosity.
- ✧ Unfamiliar yet inviting opportunities in the out-of-doors that challenge and excite.
- ✧ Direct experiences with nature that increase children's understanding of the diverse habitats in their own backyard.
- ✧ Multi-sensory arts, crafts and cooking activities that encourage experimentation, discovery, and independence.
- ✧ Opportunities to dictate stories and create charts, books, or letters, imparting environmental education into language, math, and art.
- ✧ Cooperative play time that strengthens children's social skills and emotional development.
- ✧ Music and movement activities.
